### A few rules

- Only one entry per category per person can be accepted.
- Each category entry costs 50p; 25p for under-16s categories – although children are welcome to enter the other categories as well..
- Age is on the day of the fête (but only matters if you're under 16).
- All entries must have been made, or grown, within 3 miles of Hyde Heath Common
- All entries, with forms and money must be delivered between 11:00 and 12:00am, and can be picked up (with your prizes) from 3:30 – after 4:15 items may be disposed of. The judges may sample entries. Judging will be from 1200-1300, and fête-goers can see the entries from 1330.
- Gardens on a plate must be on a plate between 20cm and 30cm across and be mainly of plants.
- Jars of jam, chutney, etc. must be between 250ml and 500ml in volume, and have been made since the last fête.
- Each category where there are at-least 6 entries will win
  - 1<sup>st</sup> prize: £1.50 & 3 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: £1.00 & 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: £50p & 1 point.
- Each category where there are 3-5 entries will win: 1<sup>st</sup> prize: £1 & 3 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: 50p & 2 points
- Anybody under 16 who wins an “all ages” category gets 4 points for that instead of 3.
- The person with the most points from their best 11 categories, wins the best of show trophy. If there's a tie, it goes to the person with most first places, then if that is still tied, most second places, and so on.

#### **Grown things (any age)**

1. 6 spring onions
2. 4 sticks of rhubarb
3. 4 asparagus shoots
4. 3 leeks
5. A cabbage, lettuce, or kale
6. A plate of chard, spinach or rocket

#### **Grown things (age up to 11)**

7. A garden on a plate
8. A pot of herbs I grew myself

#### **Grown things (age 12 up to 15)**

9. A garden on a plate
10. A pot of herbs I grew myself

#### **Made things**

11. A decorated sponge cake weighing between 0.5 and 1.0kg
12. 6 bread rolls
13. A plate containing 6 homemade biscuits
14. A jar of sweet jam, marmalade, jelly or fruit curd
15. A jar of savoury marmalade or chutney

#### **Made things (age up to 11)**

16. 6 homemade sweets
17. A drawing or painting of somewhere in Hyde Heath, up to A4 in size
18. An animal made from fruit or vegetables

#### **Made things (age 12-15)**

19. 6 homemade sweets
  20. 6 bread rolls
  21. 6 cup cakes.
